# Badgett/Jones Scholarship

In the winter of 2002, the members of Campbellsville Baptist Church established the Badgett/Jones Scholarship Fund at Campbellsville University. This scholarship was formed to honor two former pastors and their combined 50 years of excellence in pastoral ministry, Dr. J. Chester Badgett (1950–1980) and Dr. James E. Jones (1981–2001).

As Dr. Skip Alexander stated, ***“This endowed scholarship fund is intended to recognize and honor two significant individuals for their leadership roles at Campbellsville Baptist Church and their belief in Christian higher education through Campbellsville University.”***

The Badgett/Jones Scholarship is awarded to Campbellsville University ministry students who serve Campbellsville Baptist Church through an internship. The recipient is selected by the ministerial staff and University Relations/Scholarship Committee of Campbellsville Baptist Church along with the Office of Church and External Relations of Campbellsville University. The recipient is selected prior to the beginning of the academic semester and agrees to serve 20 hours a week in a ministry-related activity for the church. The award is made in scholarship amounts based on funds available and the number of students selected.

The goal of the internship is to provide the ministry student with a better understanding of the duties of a minister and enter into a mentoring relationship toward equipping the student for ministry.

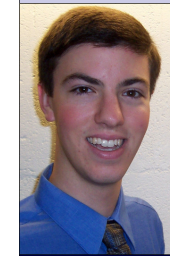

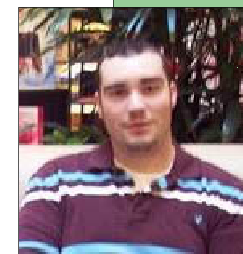
